

Staughton Vale Campus 2023 Program

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child will be involved in the Staughton Vale Middle School Program at the Staughton Vale Campus in 2023. It is a unique outdoor learning environment that provides the opportunity for students to engage in hands on activities that are challenging, expand their knowledge of food sustainability/security, and connect them with the natural environment. Students will be immersed in rich learning experiences that support and enhance the curriculum taught in Year 7.

Staughton Vale Campus

The Staughton Vale Campus, 155 Staughton Vale Road, is situated on the fringe of the Brisbane Ranges National Park, near Anakie and consists of over 200 acres of fertile pastures, orchards, dams and natural forest.

Program

Year 7 students will travel to the campus twice over the course of the year. The first experience will focus on developing field skills in geography. Students will participate in three activities with their Geography teacher that are designed to collect and present data that will explore the central theme of 'enhancing liveability'. These activities will include:

- Field sketching to identify current liveability features,
- Data collection on natural hazards, and
- Mapping features designed to enhance liveability.

Transport:

Students will leave Bacchus Marsh Grammar at 9.00am by bus and return in the afternoon for normal dismissal at 3.20pm.

Uniform and Equipment:

Students will be required to wear <u>PE uniform</u> with either runners or hiking boots (if they have them). The following equipment is required for day trip to Staughton Vale.

- BMG Waterproof jacket
- BMG Sports Jumper and tracksuit pants
- Sunscreen and hat
- Full water bottle
- Morning tea and packed lunch (preferably packaging free to help reduce waste to landfill)
- Pencil case, workbook and clipboard



All students attending are required to have their <u>Student ID card</u> for logging on/off the bus

It is recommended that all students 8 years and over wear a <u>fitted face mask</u> whilst travelling on public transport (this includes to and from school, excursions, and camps) unless they have a medical exemption
