Dear Parents/Guardians,

It has been announced today that Moorabool Shire is to go into a seven-day lockdown from midnight tonight, with similar settings to Metropolitan Melbourne.

As such the arrangements for next week are:

- i) Woodlea will commence online learning on Monday 4 October for all classes. Vulnerable children and children of people on the authorised provider and authorised worker list are able to continue attending onsite.
- ii) Maddingley will commence online learning for all classes on Monday 4 October. There will be a modified online program for Unit 3/4 students on Monday with further details to follow. Maddingley will be open for vulnerable children or the children of authorised workers.
- iii) The GAT will proceed on Tuesday, 5 October for students studying a Unit 3/4 subject. I remind students who reside in the following postcodes: 3021; 3023; 3029; 3030; 3037; 3046; 3047; 3048; 3059; 3060; 3061; 3064; 3073; 3074; 3075; 3076; 3082; 3338; 3750; 3752; 3754; 3977 are required to be COVID tested on the 2 or 3 October.
- iv) Unit 3/4 classes and final year VCAL classes will commence on Wednesday, 6 October in face-to-face mode. We are currently seeking further clarification of whether Year 11 students can attend their Unit 3/4 classes face-to-face or need to continue online learning.

The situation generally and those related to school is enormously fluid; it is almost certain that arrangements will change in the coming days. I would ask that you remain patient and stay safe in these difficult times.
